Annual Community Meeting:

The annual community meeting was held June 18, 2014 at Broadneck Elementary School. Highlights from the meeting include:

- Special recognition to Mary Kimmel and Ray Chronister for their work in the community. Congratulations and thank you to Mary for her tireless work with the front entrance and garden committee, and to Ray and his wife Lin, for their many years of service to the community as members of the board of directors.
- The front entrance committee presented a report on the front entrance and the survey sent out earlier to the community. Of the responses received it appears the community favors two matching walls made of stone. Work will continue on the design. Thank you to the front entrance committee for all your hard work.
- Members were given time to ask questions of the attorney (Ellen Throop) for the association.
- Members were given time to make comments with regard to various issues in the community.
- Jim Goldie, the treasurer presented his report to the community. The community has a 95% collection rate of community dues, but nine homes are still outstanding.
- Ray Chronister gave his report on home sales in the community. It would appear the cost of homes is decreasing rather than increasing. Time to spruce up and help our neighborhood sell!
- Paul Fitzpatrick gave his report and thoughts on the community.
- Elections took place. Four members of the community served as tabulators and our lawyer was present for the counting. At the end of the

evening, there were questions over several proxies, and the final election could not be decided until these proxies were verified.
