

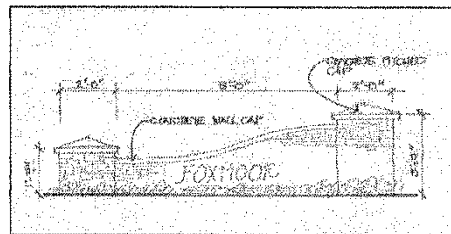

Annual Meeting:

The annual community meeting was held June 17, 2015 in the community room of the Broadneck Library. Highlights from the meeting include:

- The minutes from May were approved. They will be posted on the website for all to view.
- The budget was adopted. There were no dissensions to the budget, and the board approved the budget. The board will try to get back on track with the correct timing for the budget in the upcoming year.
- Discussion was held on a proposed amendment to the bylaws. This amendment deals with payment of legal fees if a lawsuit is filed. The community felt they should be allowed to read the proposed amendment and discuss the contents of the amendment. This will be discussed further at future meetings. The attorney for the board will also have to review the proposal to see if it is a viable proposal. Approval of any amendment to the bylaws must have a vote of a majority of a quorum of members present in person or by proxy, except that the Federal Housing Administration of the Veterans Administration shall have the right to veto amendments while there is a Class B membership.
- Voting for the board of directors took place. The following are members of the Board of Directors for 2015-2016: Dino Giurfa, Jim Goldie, Dan Henschel, Charlotte Preece and Chris Warner. Congratulations to all newly elected members!
- Voting took place for the front entrance. Elevation A was selected, and brick was chosen as the material to use.
